He is currently running an NGO for visually challenged people in the name of "<u>Lit the Light</u>". Through the NGO, he serves several blind people by training them to read and understand scripts. Year after year, more and more people have benefited from the NGO. Several blind people, part of the NGO have participated in the Blind World Cup Cricket Matches, Vijay TV Super Singer Contest and Many Competitive Exams.



- Mr. Sathya Priyan (2009 Batch Mechanical Engineering) a Master's from IIM Trichy shared his experience during college days and recalled his good memories of college life.
- Ms. Vijayalakshmi (2005 Batch Chemical Engineering) working as a Senior Manager in CAPGEMINI felt unhappy with the playground maintenance. Being a Sports Champion herself, she requested the Principal to make arrangements to clean the playground for SREC students. She was willing to volunteer for the student placements, if needed. She requested the management to fulfill the infrastructure development needs for the benefit of students on roll. She promised to come back for the next alumni meet and wished to see improvements in the maintenance of campus facilities.
